# 3-4. Using the hands-free system Hands-free system

The hands-free system is a function that allows you to use your mobile phone without touching it.

This system supports Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> mobile phones. Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> is a wireless data system that allows the mobile phone to wirelessly connect to the hands-free system and make/receive calls.

#### n When using the hands-free system

- 1 The audio system and voice guidance are muted when making a call.
- 1 If both parties speak at the same time it may be difficult to hear.
- 1 If the received call volume is overly loud, an echo may be heard.
- 1 Try to face the microphone as much as possible when speaking.
- 1 In the following circumstances it may be difficult to hear the other party.
  - When driving on unsealed roads
  - When driving at high speeds
  - If the window is open
  - If the air-conditioning is blowing directly on the microphone
  - If the air-conditioning is set to high

#### Changing the security settings

You can disable certain hands-free system functions. Use the security settings when you do not wish other people to see the registered data, for example when having the vehicle valet parked at a hotel.

To enable or disable security, the security code (4 digits) is required. The default code is "0000". Be sure to change the security code before use.
